



## Post-Season Tournament Play Selection Process

### 2007 Post-Season Tournament Play Team Selection

North King County Little League will be holding Skills Assessment Clinics for the 2007 All Star Teams, at the end of which the voting for All Stars will take place. All players and coaches applying for All Stars must attend the Skills Assessment Clinic. Note that you must be at least league age 9 to participate in Post-Season Play.

Only players who have applied for All Stars will take part in the clinic, but any player who would like to vote must come and watch the clinic to vote. Managers, coaches, board members and umpires that would like to vote must do the same. We encourage managers and coaches to come to the clinic and vote.

The Skill Assessment times and locations are as follows:

Softball (all)..... June 12..... 6:00pm ..... Hamlin 1  
Juniors / Seniors..... June 12..... 7:15pm ..... Hamlin 1

9 year olds - Baseball ..... June 13..... 5:30pm ..... Hamlin 1  
10 year olds - Baseball ..... June 13..... 6:15pm ..... Hamlin 1  
11 year olds - Baseball ..... June 13..... 7:00pm ..... Hamlin 1  
12 year olds – Baseball ..... June 13..... 7:45pm ..... Hamlin 1

Player/Parent/Coach Meeting ..... June 16..... 9:00am ..... Hamlin 1

The name of each eligible player-applicant will be placed on the ballot. The players that participate or come and watch the Skills Assessment will cast their votes for the players they feel will best represent their division of North King County Little League. The Managers, Coaches, Team Umpires and Board of Directors that attend the clinic may also cast ballots.

**All Star Teams will be announced no later than Friday, June 15<sup>th</sup>.**

#### Submittal Deadline & Questions

Please return the attached form by mailing it directly to NKCLL, PO Box 55402, Shoreline, WA 98155 **postmarked no later than June 9<sup>th</sup>**. The application must be submitted by you or your parent/guardian. Do not deliver it to your Manager. Please email your player agent and the president in case your application is lost in the mail. #### Player / Parent Meeting to Explain Requirements and Turn in Paperwork:

All players selected will be asked to supply an original certified birth certificate, three proofs of residency (only one may be a utility bill), and notarized medical release form. **All players and parents will be required to attend a mandatory meeting at Hamlin Park.** All birth certificates and paperwork will be collected on that day. A notary will be available at that time. Birth certificates will be returned to parents after the tournament is completed. Tournament requirements are very stringent; so don't delay in getting your certified birth certificate ordered, if you can't find yours.

#### Manager / Coach Selection

The Board of Directors will select the tournament Managers from the list of eligible Managers. To be eligible for consideration, each Manager/ Coach must have attended Dr. Smoll's Sports Psychology clinic in the past three years and be first aid certified. The Manager, subject to approval by the Board of Directors, will select two Coaches from the list of remaining eligible Managers and Coaches. **All Managers and Coaches are required to attend a mandatory District 8 Tournament Meeting. We will notify the manager and coach as soon as the date is known.**

**Remember, all applications must be postmarked no later than:  
Saturday, June 9, 2007.**
